ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.63 dated 30.05.2015, registered under Sections 22 of the NDPS Act, Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

Heard.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that recovery is of 6 bottles of REXCOF and it would fall within small quantity and the petitioner is in custody since 30.05.2015. He states that challan has been filed.

The State counsel states that the total recovery is 600 ml. and the recovery effected from the petitioner is not commercial quantity.

The trial will take long time to conclude. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
