Learned counsel for the petitioner without pressing the prayer for cancellation of regular bail granted to respondent No1 by the Addl. Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra, vide impugned order dated 20.10.2015 (Annexure P-1), submits that Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, may be directed to look into the representation dated 31.10.2015(Annexure P-2).

Notice only to respondent No.2, at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Parveen Aggarwal DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2-State.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

In view of the above, without commenting upon the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, to look into the contents of the representation dated 31.10.2015 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate action as warranted by law.
