Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the bail petitions filed by co-accused have been dismissed and when the Court is not inclined to grant bail, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition but submits that the petitioner is in custody since 17.07.2013 and remaining two witnesses are not coming forward to record their statements.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and after considering the advance stage of the trial and also that only two more witnesses are to be examined, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn as per submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

However, the trial Court is directed to make all efforts to conclude the trial within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this Order.
