Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.38 dated 22.1.2015 under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC registered at Police Station Jagadhri City, District Yamunanagar.

Vide order dated 6.2.2015, the petitioner was granted interim protection with a direction to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 6.2.2015, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Balwant Singh, submits that he does not dispute the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and that further custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 6.2.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.
