Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Rajinder Singh Brar alleging that the petitioner along with other co-accused had hatched a conspiracy to set up fictitious company under the name of Crystal Wind Trade and the complainant was induced to invest in the same by Parmod Kumar. A sum of Rs.50,000/- had been paid to the complainant but the remaining amount had been misappropriated.

With the assistance of learned State counsel, I have gone through the police file.

The evidence regarding money transactions is oral as such it will be a debatable issue whether there is admissible evidence available regarding the money having changed hands from complainant to the petitioner.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sangrur.
