This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail to petitioner in a case registered against him vide FIR No.169 dated 03.07.2015 under Sections 15/16/27A/61/85 of Narcotic and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Kallanwali, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is in custody since July, 2015 and contraband recovered from the petitioner is non-commercial in nature.

Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer for bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner any longer. The trial may take long time to conclude. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sirsa.
