Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.131 dated 09.11.2014, under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Chhajli, District Sangrur.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 26.11.2014:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that deceased owed money to the petitioner and in this regard, petitioner had served a notice on the deceased through his counsel.

Notice of motion for 06.02.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal

Procedure, 1973.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Head Constable Ram Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 26.11.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
