This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.107 dated 17.10.2014 registered under Sections 353, 186 and 506 IPC at Police Station Haryana, Hoshiarpur (Annexure P1) on the basis of compromise dated 14.11.2014 (Annexure P2).

Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hoshiarpur has recorded statements of the complainant and the accused. It is reported that the parties have entered into compromise. The compromise is without any pressure, coercion and is genuine.

As the dispute has amicably been settled, therefore, the

FIR No.107 dated 17.10.2014 registered under Sections 353, 186

and 506 IPC at Police Station Haryana, Hoshiarpur alongwith consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
