Through the instant petition under Section 482 CrPC the petitioner seeks a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.6 to 16. He has claimed that he has filed representation Annexure P-1 against the mental harrassment at the hands of private respondents to the police but no action has been taken.

In the reply filed, State has denied receipt of any representation Annexure P-1, however it has been explained in the reply that the petitioner used to visit a lady and create nuisance at Gobindgarh.

Without entering into controversy at this stage, the settlement of controversy raised by the parties does not appear to be within the ambit of

parameters of consideration in exercise of extraordinary powers under Section 482 CrPC.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana to consider the averments in Annexure P-1, and in case the averments are correct, to take action and if allegations are found to be false, then to drop the matter.

It will be appreciated in case necessary steps are taken expeditiously preferably within a period of three months.
