JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J. (Oral)

By way of petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.471, dated 20.6.2015, registered under Sections 420/467/468/471/34 of the Indian Penal Code (for the 'the IPC') at Police Station City Jind, District Jind.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner himself is a victim in the instant case. He refers to Annexure P-1, the complaint made by the petitioner along with one Manjit Singh, who is the complainant in the present FIR. Vide Annexure P-2, the Deputy Commissioner, East Gurgaon send the matter for further investigation to the Director Vigilance (Recruitment), Rail Bhawan, which has so far not

been finalised.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel submits that apart from these two complaints, nine other complaints have been received against the petitioner. The petitioner has been running a documentation centre in the name and style of S. K. Computer Center, Jind and involved in fabricating the documents such as application for jobs, identity cards. As per the investigation, the petitioner has received approximately Rs.1,65,00,000/- from various complainants, on the assurance of securing job in the railways.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record with their able assistance.

Considering the number of complaints against the petitioner and the manner in which the offence allegedly has been committed, no case for bail is made out at this stage.

Dismissed.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be taken to be an opinion on merits of the case.
