Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.121 dated 06.10.2014, under Sections 336, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 26.11.2014:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR No.121 dated 06.10.2014 under Sections 336, 506, 34 IPC and 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga is a counter blast to the incident which took place on 04.10.2014 wherein petitioner No.2 was injured and admitted to Civil Hospital, Moga. He has produced the MLR which indicates injury on the head. He has filed a complaint but no action has been taken thereof.

Notice of motion for 09.01.2015.

In the meantime the petitioners shall be granted

interim bail to the satisfaction of arresting officer/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall remain bound by the conditions as envisaged by Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Head Constable Gurcharan Singh has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioners vide order dated 26.11.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
