Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR no.73 dated 11.4.2014 under Sections 399,402 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, PS Sohana,Distt.SAS Nagar,Mohali.

It was contended that non-appearance of the petitioner was bonafide.

Vide order dated 1.12.2015 while issuing notice of motion it was directed that in the event of petitioner surrendering before the trial court within four days, he would be released on interim bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this Court, petitioner has surrendered before the trial court and has been released on interim bail and he is ready to face trial.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Amarjit Singh does not refute the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, interim bail granted by the trial court is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
