As per counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner joined investigation and also he is living with complainant-Amandeep Kaur. The latter, who is the wife of the petitioner, had lodged the FIR under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, in Police Station Women Cell, Patiala. It appears that since the parties concerned are living together, for that reason no one has appeared for the complainant.

State counsel, on instructions of ASI Gurjit Singh of Police Station Women Cell, Patiala, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation.

The complainant had not opposed the request of the petitioner for bail as is incorporated in the order dated 30.09.2014.

The interim relief granted to the petitioner on 18.12.2013 is, therefore, made absolute.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
