Petitioners have preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents to comply with the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C. in case the presence of the petitioners is required in connection with any investigation or inquiry and further for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.2 to 5 not to unnecessarily harass the petitioners by compelling them to come to police station without reasonable cause or jurisdiction.

Learned counsel for the petitioners only prays for the relief that the representation dated 03.11.2015 (Annexure P-1), given to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, by petitioner No.1 be considered and he does not press the other relief asked in this petition.

In view of above, respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar is directed to look into the said representation (Annexure P-1); take appropriate action as per law and pass appropriate order within two month from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
