Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.134, dated 03.12.2014, under Sections 364/34, IPC, registered at Police Station Kathu Nangal, Amritsar (Rural).

Vide order dated 09.02.2015, this Court has passed the following orders:-

Petitioner is a lady, who seeks the concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Baljit Kaur alleging that her daughter Amandeep Kaur had been kidnapped alongwith gold and money.

Notice of motion for April 10, 2015.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the petitioner will join investigation on February 21, 2015, and in case of her doing so, she will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Sub

Inspector- Dalip Kumar states that pursuant to the order dated

09.02.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation and even challan has been presented in the case. Therefore, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

Accordingly, order dated 09.02.2015 is made absolute and the present petition is disposed of.
