SABINA, J

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 read with Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in complaint No.222 dated 03.12.2012, under Section 3 of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

While issuing, notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 27.11.2014:-

"Having been summoned in a private complaint filed by Rachhpal Singh respondent, petitioner has approached this Court for pre-arrest bail. Application for pre-arrest bail filed by the petitioners has been dismissed by the Additional Sessions Judge on the ground that it is not maintainable. The petitioners have got property dispute with Dilbagh Singh. As per the complaint, complainant Rachhpal Singh is employed with Dilbagh Singh and had allegedly been abused in the name of his caste. Prima facie, it appears that the complainant has been used by his employer to

settle other scores.

Notice to the respondent for 02.03.2015.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that petitioners will put in appearance before the summoning Court within a period of 15 days from today. In case of their doing so, they will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the said Court."

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in pursuance to the above order, petitioners have surrendered before the trial Court 02.12.2014 and have furnished the necessary bail bonds.

Accordingly, the interim bail furnished by the petitioners, before the trial Court, in pursuance to the order dated 27.11.2014 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
