RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondents No.4 to 9.

Learned counsel for respondents No.4 to 9 submits that they have no objection in respect of matrimonial tie of petitioner No.1 with petitioner No.2. Respondents No.11 and 12 are parents of petitioner No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions from petitioner No.2, identifies respondents No.11 and 12, who have also stated that they have no objection to the matrimonial tie between the petitioners.

However, in the event of any threat perception by petitioner, they would be at liberty to approach respondents No.2 and 3 by way of representation and in the event of receiving such a representation, respondents No.2 and 3 would be obligated to take lawful action as permissible under the law.
