This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.198 dated 15.10.2014 under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 148, 149, 427 IPC and Section 308 IPC (added later on vide DDR No.24 dated 13.11.2014), registered at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar.

Counsel for the State on instructions from SI Surjit Singh has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 29.12.2014 and one iron road has since been recovered from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the said fact, the order dated 19.12.2014 passed by this Court is made absolute till the presentation of the challan and thereafter the petitioner shall furnish fresh bail/surety bonds before the Magistrate, which shall be accepted by the Magistrate to its satisfaction.

Disposed of accordingly.
