Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking regular bail in FIR No.257 dated 05.07.2014, under Sections 21, 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Tarn Taran City.

Heard.

As per the prosecution case, on the basis of secret information, accused Bhajan Singh was arrested and twelve kilogram heroin, two pistols along with twelve live cartridges were recovered from him. During investigation, accused Bhajan Singh named the petitioner and petitioner was arrested on 06.07.2015. On the basis of disclosure statement suffered by the petitioner, 1 kilo 500 grams of heroin was recovered.

Medical record of the petitioner has been placed on record. A perusal of Annexure P-1 reveals that the petitioner has been recently diagnosed with triple vessel disease and is under treatment. Petitioner was advised to undergo an operation but he had refused to do so. The name of the petitioner has been included in the list of terminally ill patients on 21.07.2015.

Since the recovery of commercial quantity of the contraband has been effected from the petitioner and petitioner is being provided requisite medical treatment, no ground for grant of bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
