Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case NCB Crime No. 27, dated 19.07.2014, for the offences punishable under Sections 08, 18, 29 and 60 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered at Police Station N.C.B., Chandigarh.

As per allegations, recovery of 5 kgs. 200 grams of opium was made from the conscious possession of the petitioner/accused. The said quantity concededly is commercial in nature.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that out of five witnesses to be examined by the prosecution, total four stand examined and the case for cross-examination of fifth witness is fixed for 23.12.2015.

In view of the stage of the trial, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
