INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.244 dated 17.09.2015, registered at Police Station Sadar, Ferozepur, under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

As per FIR, Seeto wife of the petitioner was apprehended with 260 grams heroine and she told the police that the said heroine was brought to her by her husband Mangal Singh-petitioner. Firstly, the recovery effected from the wife of the petitioner falls in commercial quantity. As the petitioner-accused has been nominated by his wife during investigation and the origin of the heroine is to be investigated, therefore, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is

required in this case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, I do not find any ground to grant the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, finding no merit in the instant petition, the same is dismissed.
