Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner namely Pankaj in case FIR No.160 dated 29.10.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 498-A, 406 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Civil Lines, Batala.

It is contended that the petitioner is ready and willing for a full and final amicable settlement.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the directions passed by this Court the accused husband and complainant-wife are present in Court.

Complainant states that amicable settlement has been arrived at

between the parties and she has no objection if the anticipatory bail granted to the petitioner is confirmed.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Manjit Singh also acknowledges the aforesaid fact.

In view of the aforesaid circumstances, the present petition is allowed and it is ordered that in the event of his arrest, petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the arresting/investigating officer. However, he shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.PC.

However, it is clarified that in case if there is any violation of the terms of the compromise, the complainant/prosecution will be free to seek recalling of the present order.

Disposed of in the above terms.
