After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition at this stage with liberty to file afresh after some prosecution evidence is led. He, however, prays that the personal appearance of the petitioners, who are parents-in-law of respondent No.2, before the trial court may be exempted. This prayer is not opposed by the learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.

In case the petitioners move an application for exemption of their personal appearance, the same shall be considered by the trial court in accordance with law. The trial court may exempt the personal appearance of the petitioners on such terms & conditions, as it deems proper to impose. The said petitioners may be allowed to appear through their counsel except on the dates when their presence is necessary.
