Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in cross case DDR No.28 dated 21.09.2014, under Sections 324, 323, 34, of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' for short) (Sections 325, 326, 148, 149 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Chohla Sahib in main case FIR No.108 dated 18.09.2014, under Sections 452, 324, 323, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 325, 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 28.11.2014:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that it is a case of version and cross version.

Notice of motion for 10.02.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioners be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. They shall abide by the

conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Darbara Singh has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioners vide order dated 28.11.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
