By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.474, dated 28.10.2015, registered under Section 15 NDPS Act, at Police Station Murthal, Sonapat.

The learned counsel contends that the alleged recovery of 24 kg. of poppy husk was effected from the co-accused Vicky. In pursuance of the order dated 01.12.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has

joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 01.12.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
