Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners would submit that as of date the petitioners are not apprehending any threat to their life and liberty.

Learned State counsel has filed in Court today a short reply by way of affidavit dated 24.3.2015 of the Dy.S.P., R-I, Gurdaspur and the same is taken on record. Perusal of the affidavit would reveal that both the petitioners have suffered statements which are appended as Annexures R-I/T and R-II/T stating before the local police that they do not require any police protection.

Under such circumstances, no further directions are required to be passed and the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioners is, accordingly, disposed of as infructuous.
