INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.71 dated 14.05.2015, registered at Police Station Raikot, Distt. Ludhiana, under Sections 15 and 25 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (in short 'the Act').

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Simsi Dhir Malhotra, DAG, Punjab, has accepted notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

As per prosecution version, 64 kgs. poppy husk was recovered from Innova car driven by the petitioner i.e. from the possession of the petitioner which falls in commercial quantity.

Section 37 of the Act bars to grant the bail to the person in case of commercial quantity.

Therefore, finding no merit in the instant petition, the same is dismissed.
