1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?

REKHA MITTAL, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of bail in FIR No. 13 dated 2.3.2014, registered at Police Station, Sekhwan, District Gurdaspur for offence punishable under Section 306 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that a false FIR has been registered against all the members of in-laws family of the deceased with an intent to deprive Jagmohan Kaur, wife of the deceased of her right to inherit to estate of the deceased. The petitioner is the mother-in-law of the deceased and no longer required for the purpose of investigation as challan has been presented in the Court. She is ready to face proceedings in

accordance with law and conclusion of trial is likely to take some time.

Counsel for the State of Punjab would submit that charge has been framed, 04 out of 14 witnesses have already been examined and every effort will be made to complete evidence of the prosecution shortly.

Without meaning to express any opinion on merits of the controversy, the petition stands disposed of with a direction that in case the prosecution fails to conclude its evidence within another three months and delay is not attributable to the petitioner or her co-accused, the petitioner shall be released on bail on her furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court. However, she shall remain bound by the following conditions:-

- (i) she shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and
- (ii) she shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.
