Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.107 dated 24.10.2013, registered at Police Station Badni Kalan, District Moga, under Sections 336, 506, 307, 120-B, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of Arms Act (added later on).

Learned State counsel after seeking instructions from the investigating officer submits that all the eye witnesses have been examined and case is at the fag end. There are twelve other FIRs against the petitioner.

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Being faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the instant petition, however, prays that trial Court may be directed to expedite the trial.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Trial Court is directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same preferably within three months.

Prosecution is directed to ensure the presence of all the unexamined witnesses before the trial Court on the date fixed.
