Reply on behalf of State filed in the Court today
is taken on record.

Learned State counsel on instructions from A.S.I,
Jagtar Singh, Police Station City Samana, District Patiala has
made a statement in the Court that at present the police do not
intend to register any FIR or arrest the petitioner on the basis of
the present allegations.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the
petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition. However, in
view of the apprehension expressed by the learned counsel for the
petitioner that the petitioner in future might be illegally arrested or
detained by the police, thus, a direction is issued to the Police

Station, City Samana, District Patiala that in case the petitioner is required in any cognizable case they will issue seven day's notice to the petitioner to enable him to take recourse of law.
