INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.115 dated 30.10.2015, registered at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Ropar, under Sections 409, 420 IPC.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

As per FIR, the allegations are levelled against the petitioner, who is Secretary of the Cooperative Society. Perusal of the order dated 09.11.2015, passed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Rupnagar, shows that the accounts of those persons, who have already died, were also operated and a huge amount has been withdrawn and the petitioner-accused had played fraud with the Co-operative Society to the amount of ₹12,81,129/-.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the

present case; the nature and gravity of the offence and the serious allegations levelled against the petitioner regarding the embezzlement of the amount and forging so many documents, his custodial interrogation is required.

Therefore, finding no ground to grant the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, the instant petition stands dismissed.
