Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.828 dated 27.09.2014, under Section 379 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Gurgaon.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 29.11.2014:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner did not report for duty as he had been involved in a criminal case and has been granted benefit of anticipatory bail by the Sessions Court.

Notice of motion for 10.02.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant

Sub Inspector Dalbir Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 29.11.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
