The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.7 dated 18.01.2014 registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 & 120-B IPC at Police Station Kulgarhi, District Ferozpur.

The allegations against the petitioner were of cheating the complainant by getting his name incorporated in the revenue record without there being any sale deed in his favour.

It had been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that by virtue of registered document Annexure P-1 the property had been transferred in the name of petitioner by Piara Singh on the basis of sale deed, which was the basis of entry in the revenue record.

Noticing the aforesaid, the petitioner was granted interim protection vide order dated 01.12.2014 pursuant to which he has joined investigation, which fact has not been controverted by learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Narender Singh.

Considering the aforesaid facts and noticing that the petitioner has since joined the investigation, the instant petition is allowed. The interim orders dated 01.12.2014 are hereby made

absolute subject to condition that the petitioner would continue to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
