The instant petition was filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C read with Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.153 dated 21.12.2011 under Section 3 of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act 1989 and Section 506 I.P.C registered at Police Station Sadar Khanna, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana.

Counsel appearing for the petitioners has produced in Court today a certified copy of the order dated 11.12.2014 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana. Copy of the same is taken on record as Mark A. Perusal of the same would reveal that in deference of the order dated 3.12.2014 passed by this Court, both the petitioners had duly appeared before the Trial Court and were admitted to interim bail on their furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.1 lac each with one surety each of the like amount.

Under such circumstances, the instant petition is disposed of in terms of making the order dated 3.12.2014, passed by this Court as absolute.
