AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is an a petition for regular bail filed in case bearing FIR
No. 32 dated 24.03.2014, under Sections302/307/324/148/149 IPC,
registered at Police Station Sadar Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Reply by way of affidavit of Mahinder Singh, Deputy
Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Kapurthala, District Kapurthala has
been filed on behalf of the respondent-State. Taken on record.

Learned Addl.AG has informed the Court that the cross-

examination on complainant Amarjit Singh could not be conducted on which basis the matter was sought to be adjourned on the last date. Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that this would result in further delay of the trial. The petitioner has now been in custody for the past more than 9 months and the only allegation against him is that he caused one simple injury to a witness.

In these circumstances I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of bail to the petitioner. Let him be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc. Application, if any also stands disposed of.
