This order shall dispose of the aforesaid three petitions
filed for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner/s in complaint
case bearing No. 6/2015 dated 09.01.2015 titled as Sanjay v. Vidya

Devi and others, under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC pending in the Court of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Charkhi Dadri, District Bhiwani.

Service is complete. Despite service none has entered appearance on behalf of the complainant.

On 03.12.2015 the following contention was noticed:-

“ Learned counsel has argued that the allegations pertain to a period more than five years ago. No proceedings were ever taken out by the department for these alleged embezzlements and the complaint has been filed for oblique purposes.”

Learned DAG has accepted the above said factual assertion. None has appeared on behalf of the complainant to oppose the bail.

In the circumstances I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of bail to the present petitioner/s. Let them appear before the trial Court on 08.01.2016, the date already fixed there and the trial Court shall release them on bail to his satisfaction.

Petitions stand disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc.Application, if any, stands disposed of.
