This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail to petitioner in a case registered against her vide FIR No.194 dated 18.07.2015 under Section 306 IPC at Police Station City Barnal, District Barnala.

Allegations against the petitioner is that she was pressurizing the deceased to live with her as she had illicit relation with him. The deceased was not willing but he had received repeated phone-calls compelling him to live with her. As a result of harassment, he committed suicide. Investigation has been completed and trial is in progress.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner any longer. The trial may take long time to conclude. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Barnala.
