SABINA, J

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.18 dated 02.08.2014, under Sections 406, 498-A, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Non Resident Indian Cell, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 01.12.2014:-

“Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.18 dated 2.8.2014 under Sections 406/498-A/120-B IPC, P.S NRI Cell, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are parents-in-law of the complainant. He further contends that the complainant after marriage had resided with the petitioners only for a week in 2012. Thereafter the complainant was staying at Bangalore, where she was working. It is contended that the FIR has been lodged in the year 2014 and only the allegations, which are general in nature, have

been levelled against the petitioners.

Notice of motion for 12.1.2015.

In the meantime, the petitioners shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. They shall present themselves before the Investigating Officer on 15.12.2014 and abide by all the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Gian Singh has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioners vide order dated 01.12.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
