This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing FIR No.24 dated 22.02.2013, under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Jalandhar City, on the basis of compromise along with all subsequent proceedings arising from that FIR.

Report from the trial Court has been received. It was a matrimonial dispute, which has been amicably settled.

Although, there is a report that the petitioner-Rajesh Kumar has not appeared, but counsel for the parties have stated at the bar that the parties are living together since 1½ years amicably.

So, in view of the above circumstances and in view of authority reported as, “*Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others*” 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the above said FIR stands quashed. Further proceedings in pursuant to that FIR also stands quashed.
