Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.377 dated 09.10.2014, under Sections 406, 498-A, 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 02.12.2014:-

“Notice of motion for 16.02.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioners be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. They shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”
