Petitioner-Deepak Kumar has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with the prayer for directing the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana (respondent No.2) to ensure that his life and liberty is protected at the hands of respondent Nos.3 to 8 (Officials of Narcotic Cell, Ludhiana), who are bent upon implicating the petitioner in some false cases.

Upon notice, Assistant Commissioner of Police (East), Ludhiana has filed his affidavit as reply on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. He has stated that the petitioner is a habitual offender and involved in number of crimes of smuggling, using violence, fraud etc., the following FIRs have been shown to be registered against the petitioner:-

1. FIR No.99 dated 16.04.2013, u/s 21/61/85 of NDPS Act, PS Division No.7, Ludhiana.

2. FIR No.129 dated 25.09.2011, u/s 21/61/85 of NDPS Act, P.S. Division No.7, Ludhiana.
3. FIR No.69 dated 29.04.2006, u/s 452, 356, 427, 323, 506, 148, 149, IPC, P.S. Division No.7, Ludhiana. However, the petitioner has been acquitted in this case.

It has been specifically said that the present petition has been filed only with a view to pressurize the local police and to create a bias in the mind of the Court.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
