Instant petition under Section 438 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.50 dated 26.03.2014, registered under Sections 365/366/494/506/376/120-B IPC and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, at Police Station Ajnala, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 05.05.2015, this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the

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satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

On instructions from the investigating officer, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 05.05.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
