SABINA, J

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.155 dated 08.11.2014, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 447, 285, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Buria, District Yamuna Nagar, Haryana.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 03.12.2014:-

“Petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.155, dated 08.11.2014 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 447, 285, 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Buria, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the injuries attributed to the petitioners are simple in nature and on non-vital parts of the body.

Notice of motion for 12.01.2015.

In the meantime, the petitioners shall appear before the Investigating Officer on 15.12.2014 at 10

a.m. and join the investigation. In the event of their arrest, they be admitted to interim bail by the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer to his satisfaction. They shall, however, abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Pritpal Singh has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioners vide order dated 03.12.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
