The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 242, dated 30.8.2013, registered under Sections 21/61/85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar.

At the very outset, counsel for the respondent states that the matter is now fixed before the trial Court today for evidence and the prosecution will conclude its entire evidence by 30.5.2015 subject to the petitioner not obstructing the same.

I find this fair request. Consequently, this petition is dismissed and it is directed that in case the prosecution does not conclude its entire

evidence by 30.5.2015 (subject to the petitioner not obstructing the same),
the trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail to its satisfaction.
