INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.133 dated 30.11.2013, registered at Police Station Behrampur, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 420, 120 B IPC and Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel has appeared and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the FIR has been registered on the basis of application given by complainant to SHO, Police Station Behrampur, District Gurdaspur. The said application was against co-accused Gurnam Singh and the allegation, as per FIR, was that Gurnam Singh has taken a sum of ₹2,00,000/- from the

complainant. It is stated that during the inquiry, the name of petitioner, who is wife of co-accused Gurnam Singh, has also come. The petitioner has already joined the investigation. She is not required for custodial interrogation nor anything is to be recovered from her. No useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is accepted and the order dated 09.02.2015, passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
