This is the third petition filed by the petitioner for the grant of regular bail, the first one having been dismissed on 22.4.2014 while the second on 30.6.2014.

After obtaining instructions from HC Baldev Singh, learned State counsel has informed the Court that the prosecution has since concluded its evidence and now the trial is fixed for 25.3.2015 for examination of the accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Once the trial of the case has reached its fag end, it would not be appropriate to extend the concession of bail to the petitioner.

The petition is, therefore, dismissed.
