Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.09 dated 07.01.2015, registered at Police Station Sushant Lok, Gurgaon, District Gurgaon, under Sections 498-A, 506, 406, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 09.02.2015, a Coordinate Bench of this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioners would be

released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR. The matter was also referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for amicable settlement.

However, the mediation failed as husband of complainant is residing in Sydney.

No specific allegations have been levelled against the petitioners. As per the allegations levelled against the petitioners in the FIR, they used to give some intoxicating medicines in food and some injections to the complainant which were brought from the shop of her Jeth (brother-in-law). The allegations levelled against the petitioners are general in nature. Otherwise also, the petitioners are stated to have joined the investigation.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 09.02.2015 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute. However, the petitioners will appear before the investigating officer and join the investigation, if required.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
