Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.56 dated 22.02.2009, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 324, 506 and 326, IPC, registered at Police Station, Section 17, Chandigarh and all the consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of compromise and affidavits dated 09.09.2014 (Annexures P/2 & P/3) effected between the petitioners and respondents No.2 to 4.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2, namely Uday Singh alleging that the petitioners had attacked with Kirpan and sticks upon the complainant party injuring respondents No.3 and 4.

The parties were directed to appear before the trial Court and get their statements recorded regarding the matter having been compromised. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised without any threat, pressure or coercion.

In view of above circumstances, following the judgment of Full Bench of this Court in case ***Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, 2007(3) RCR (Crl.), 1052***, this petition is allowed. The above said FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to the condition that petitioners will deposit a total sum of Rs.10,000/- with the Chandigarh State Legal Services Authority within a period of one month.
