This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.133 dated 06.08.2015 registered under Sections 61, 1, 14 of the Excise Act, at Police Station Kambo, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has accepted that the petitioner had been granted interim bail with the direction to join the investigation but states that he could not join due to the circumstances beyond his control. He further states that he does not wish to press this petition on merits but liberty may be granted to the petitioner to surrender before the Court below and move an application for regular bail and a

direction may be issued to the Court to decide the said application expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. Let the petitioner surrender before the Court below on or before 15.12.2015 and move an application for regular bail which shall be decided expeditiously by the Court.

Petition stands dismissed as not pressed in the above terms.
