Pursuant to the order dated 8.1.2015, passed by this Court, the report of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ropar, received to the effect that the statements of the complainant and the accused have been recorded. The learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ropar, has reported that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine.

It was a dispute regarding the agreement. It is stated that the entire money has been refunded.

Since the parties have amicably settled the dispute, therefore, FIR No. 47, dated 14.2.2014, registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Morinda, District Rupnagar (Annexure-P-1) alongwith all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom stand quashed.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
